ST MARY'S HAMPTON - THE ORGAN

The original organ was built in 1831 by James Chapman Bishop. There is a suggestion that it was a gift from William IV. The first organist was S S Wesley, son of the composer Samuel Wesley, grandson of the preacher Charles Wesley. The organ was moved from its original position in the west gallery (gallery no longer present) to its current position in 1879 to coincide with the inauguration of a surpliced choir. There was a substantial re-build from 1898-1900 including the addition of a pneumatic action, installation of two manuals and a pedal board, 25 stops in total. The choir organ came a bit later, as did the organ case which had to wait for a donation. The trombone stop was added in 1910. Originally hand pumped, the organ had been converted to water power by 1912. The action was converted to an electro-pneumatic design in 1975 and upgraded again to a modern electronic controller when the bellows were repaired four years ago.
